The academic advisors that I had in the early stages of my college career were not knowledgeable about what classes I should schedule and when I asked questions, they would say "I do not know." Dr. Rasheed has been the most efficient and prepared advisor that I have had.

Students in the education department should be exposed to various grade levels. In addition, they should also be allowed to chose what grade level they want to intern in and not just the school.

"Academic Advisement: I only give ""dissatisfied"" because my experience with my advisor prior to getting into the program was not the best. My advisor told me because I had not taken the Praxis I (which I was not informed about) that the chances of me getting into the program were low, and that I might as well change my major. One suggestion I have is to make sure that students that must take the Praxis I can exempt some of the content areas, based on their SAT scores from high-school. My advisor did not tell me, I found out from a friend, which saved me money as well as stress from passing every content area in my short amount of time. Within the program I wish I had received information about the Praxis I, II, and PLT way sooner, as well as the importance behind them.

Classroom Management with Dr. Fears might have been a difficult course to grasp for me. It was not because Dr. Fears was not giving out important information, because she was, it was because I feel that I received the top layer of classroom management (which is of course important). I think having another course to support and implement classroom management personally will set up teachers for success.
