Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID with the United States Department of Education at https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch. BOTH STUDENT AND PARENT NEED AN FSA ID.	
Complete the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.studentaid.gov/h/apply-aid/fafsa , include USC Aiken school code 003449, and CONSENT to the transfer of your federal tax informat

2. COMPLETING SC SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS – SC RESIDENTS ONLY	
SC residents who meet the requirements to receive the SC HOPE Scholarship, SC LIFE Scholarship, Palmetto Fellows Scholarship, or SC Need-based Grant must sign the State Scholarship/Grant Certification each year in order to receive the fund.  - 2. Select the Financial Aid tab, select Financial Aid Dashboard
 - 3. Select the Offer tab to accept awards
 - 4. Accept/Decline awards and click **Submit**
 - You can accept a partial amount, accept the full amount, or decline.
- If you choose to accept Federal Direct Student Loans, you must complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Entrance Counseling. Go to https://studentaid.gov/, use your FAFSA login information to complete these loan requirements under the Complete Aid Process tab.
 - When you have completed your MPN and Entrance Counseling, allow 24-48 hours for the system to update your account. Loans will not disburse until the week before classes begin.
