## 4. COMPLETING LEGAL STATE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

#### For South Carolina Residents:

All new students who are residents of South Carolina must complete the Residency Certification Form to confirm residency status. Until the Residency Certification Form is completed, students are considered non-residents and will be charged out-of-state tuition rates.

# For Legal Residents of Richmond County or Columbia County, Georgia:

<b>Business Services Payment Plan</b> - An option for paying tuition, fees, and on-campus housing charges through regularly scheduled payments.
